- ◆ **workplace training:** skills and better pay
- ◆ **life skills:** budgeting, ESL, GED
- ◆ **tuition assistance:** an advanced degree
- ◆ **financial stability:** credit counseling, 401K, college and other savings plans
- ◆ **public assistance:** applying and navigating
- ◆ **housing:** affordable rentals or home buying
- ◆ **transportation:** public, repairs, car purchase

COMMON QUESTIONS

What happens when I call my LERN Success Coach? To help you best, we will need to ask you some details about your situation. We may need to see you in person and will try to be flexible around your work schedule. We will coordinate services to address your concern and support you as you work through it.

Will you share information with my employer? Not unless you give us consent. Sometimes we may need to verify some basic job information with your employer. This could be wages, date of hire or attendance history. Personal information can be confidential and we will not disclose why you are seeking assistance.
